Dear Colleague:

As you know, the FDIC's Board of Directors is scheduled to announce on Tuesday, September 29, 2009 how it proposes to **replenish the Deposit Insurance Fund's** critically dwindling reserves. I wanted to let you know CBA of Georgia and Independent Community Bankers of America are fighting just as hard to protect the interests of community banks as we did when the last proposed FDIC **special assessment** threatened to gut already severely strained community bank capital ratios and profitability.

We wanted to let you know how you can access information on the actions scheduled for Tuesday:

- On Tuesday, September 29, 2009, the FDIC Board of Directors will meet at 10 a.m. (Eastern time) to propose an action plan to rebuild the Deposit Insurance Fund. This board meeting can be accessed via webcast by [clicking here](#).
- Tuesday afternoon at 1 p.m. (Eastern time), FDIC Chairman Sheila Bair will participate in a conference call regarding the board's proposed action plan. **This conference call is open to all bankers** and can be accessed through the toll-free number (888) 790-3946. Enter the pass code 1598307.
