



John McNair Named to Georgians First Task Force and National Housing Finance Committee

ATLANTA, August 2, 2019 – On Monday, July 22, 2019, John McNair, President & CEO, [Community Bankers Association of Georgia](#), was appointed to serve on the Georgian’s First Commission Access to Capital Task Force and the ICBA Subcommittee on Housing Finance.

The Georgians First Commission was established by Governor Kemp to review state regulations, policies, and procedures to streamline government, remove inefficiencies, and secure Georgia's place as the top state for small business in the country.

“The invitation is a clear indication that the Administration recognizes the vital role community banks play in the overall Georgia economy as well as its commitment to making sure community banks have access to capital. It is an honor to represent Georgia’s community banks,” commented Mr. McNair.

Earlier this spring, John was also appointed to the [Independent Community Bankers of America’s \(ICBA\)](#) Housing Finance Subcommittee which advocates for the role of community banks in providing mortgage credit to American consumers. Committee members examines housing finance policies, including regulatory and legislative proposals, government-sponsored enterprise operations and reform, and the Federal Home Loan Banks. Whenever possible, the subcommittee supports housing finance policies that will foster reasonable and equitable treatment of community banks.
